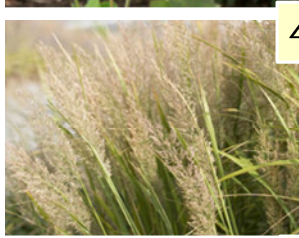


Goldenrod 'Fireworks' throws a cheerful splash of golden yellow into the fall palette, as its name suggests. This great native has superb drought tolerance and spreads readily.



Coral Bells 'Autumn Bride' is a captivating native plant through most of the year. It boasts velvety chartreuse foliage through Spring and Summer, with masses of creamy blooms in late Summer/Fall.

Anemones are a superstar plant for Fall because of their color, form, and long bloom time. They produce numerous flowers through November, which turn into cottony seed heads after flowering.



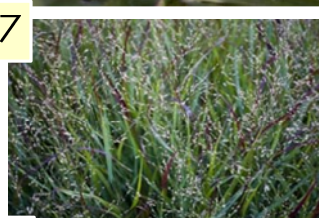
Feather Reed Grass produces beautiful seed-heads which fade to pink, surrounded by lime green foliage. Its form is elegant, but beware, it reseeds readily.

Bottle Gentian flowers are truly unique - a stunning blue/purple in Fall, as well as intriguing structure. It works best when planted with a companion plant for support, such as Amsonia.



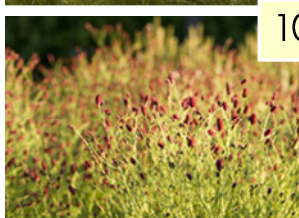
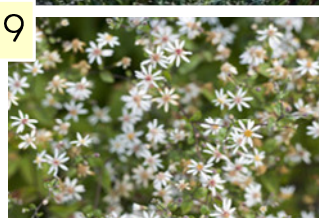
Autumn Moor Grass is one of the Lurie Garden's top ten plants. Its leaves change to chartreuse when planted in full sun, and a deep green in partial shade. A must for any garden.

Red Switch Grass is a grass for all seasons, and is a companion plant for Rattlesnake Master. The seed heads float above the red tinged foliage. This native grass is highly adaptive.



Prairie Dropseed is a stunning performer in the garden from Summer through Winter. The leaf blades of this native cascade gracefully. Blooms in late summer exude a unique sweet fragrance.

White Wood Aster, like Anemone, blooms into November. Masses of tiny white flowers create a relaxing carpet of color. This native looks best when planted in mass and can tolerate dry shade.



Burnet adds a beautiful wine red color to the fall palette in tandem with elegant foliage. Birds love to nibble the seed heads.
